

# GOLF CART RULES

1. PEDESTRIANS ALWAYS GET THE RIGHT OF WAY.
2. ALL OCCUPANTS MUST BE SEATED WHEN THE CART IS IN MOTION – NO LAP RIDING.
3. OCCUPANTS MUST KEEP ARMS, LEGS, AND FEET WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE CART WHILE IN MOTION.
4. PETS MAY RIDE ON THE CARTS, BUT MUST REMAIN UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.
5. CARTS MAY ONLY BE DRIVEN ON THE ROADWAYS OR SPECIFIED PATHWAYS OF THE CAMPGROUND.
6. CARTS WILL BE DRIVEN NO FASTER THAN A BRISK WALK OR 10 MPH. IF YOU ARE KICKING UP DUST, REDUCE SPEED.
7. MAINTAIN ADEQUATE DISTANCES FROM OTHER VEHICLES AND PEDESTRIANS ON SITE.
8. FOLLOW BASIC TRAFFIC LAWS AT ALL TIMES.
9. ALL TRAFFIC, NO PARKING, HANDICAPPED ACCESS, AND NO TRESPASSING TYPE SIGNS APPLY TO GOLF CARTS ON PREMISES.
10. GOLF CARTS MAY NOT BE DRIVEN ON SITE DURING QUIET HOURS (STAFF & SECURITY ARE EXCLUDED).
11. CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL WHILE OPERATING THE CART IS PROHIBITED BY THE OPERATOR AND ALL OCCUPANTS.
12. THERE WILL BE ZERO TOLERANCE FOR UNSAFE OPERATORS.
