



SAFETY BULLETIN: Self-Inspections

When complacency settles in, accidents occur. Conducting self-inspections and daily walkthroughs allows you as a car wash employee to ensure that everyone, customers and coworkers alike, are going to have a safe experience at your wash and keeping your wash in top-notch condition.

- ◆ Identify any slip, trip, and fall hazards that could cause an accident around the wash.
- ◆ During winter months, use a salt log to track how frequently salt is spread to prevent icy conditions from building up.
- ◆ Use a check-list to help guide you through your walkthrough to make sure you are not missing any aspect of the self-inspection.
- ◆ Make sure that nets are pulled and secured over any open pits not in use and that the nets are in proper working condition.
- ◆ Ensure tunnel cover plates are properly secured in place.
