

## **SAFETY BULLETIN: Video Surveillance & Storage**

Making sure your wash is properly protected is important when it comes to deterring vandals and thieves from attacking. Having security cameras and lighting in key locations throughout your wash are just a few ways to ensure you're protected as best as you can be. Here are a few tips to help you make sure your security is where it should be.

- Security Cameras should be equipped with night vision capabilities, be weatherproof, and give you clear detailed images.
- Cameras should cover locations such as inside the tunnel, change machines, pay stations, ATM's, vending machines, cashier areas, vacuum stations, entrances, lube shop bays, and store areas.
- Video storage over 30 days is essential, the longer you store the footage the better your protection level
- Security lighting is essential. Be sure you light up all areas of the property so nighttime activity can be monitored.
- Areas such as pay stations, change machines, ATM's and vending machines should have security lighting.
- Post warning signs around the more susceptible areas of your wash.
