






FIREWORK SAFETY TIPS

What would summer be without parades, backyard barbecues and fireworks? If you are shooting off fireworks this summer, know the risks and stay safe with these safety tips!

-  Only light one firework at a time on a smooth, flat surface away from any flammable materials.
-  Obey all local laws and follow all instructions and warnings on the packaging.
-  Have a charged hose or buckets of water nearby in case of fire.
-  Stay away from a firework that has not gone off- **DO NOT RELIGHT!**
-  Dispose of all fireworks by soaking them in water before putting them in the trash.

Did you know?

- ★ Sparklers can heat up to over 1,200 °F!
- ★ Always wear closed toe shoes and stand at least 6 ft. apart.
- ★ Hold sparklers away from the body at least one arm's length away.
- ★ Little children have little arms and may not be old enough to hold.
- ★ Use one sparkler at a time and don't run or throw them once lit.
