-  Begin by reviewing your organization's procedures and protocols. Does your cleaning policy include wiping down common surfaces such as door handles, food scoops, or kennel handles?
-  Should your organization need to scale back staffing, consider how many animals you have in the shelter and what are the minimum staffing capabilities you would need to provide proper care.
-  For staff that have to report, implement social distancing practices such as:
 - Keeping a distance of 6ft. from one another
 - Discontinue handshakes or intentional touches
 - Refrain from large group gatherings, such as staff meetings or pet fairs
-  As your staff continue taking in surrenders and conducting rescues out in the community make sure they are properly supplied with gloves, sanitizer, and cleaning materials.
